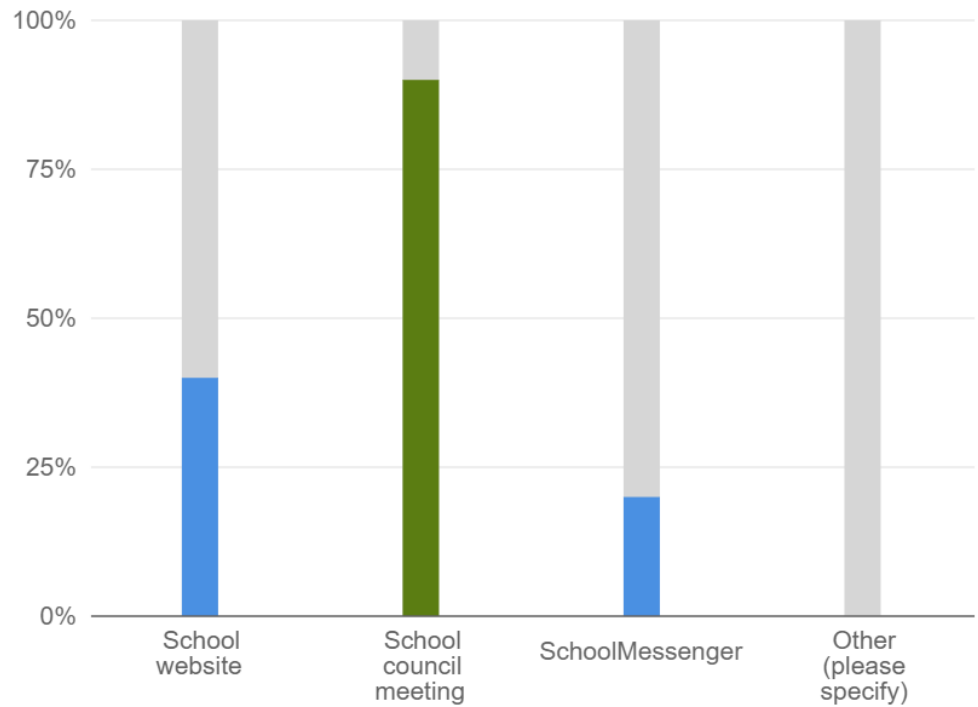

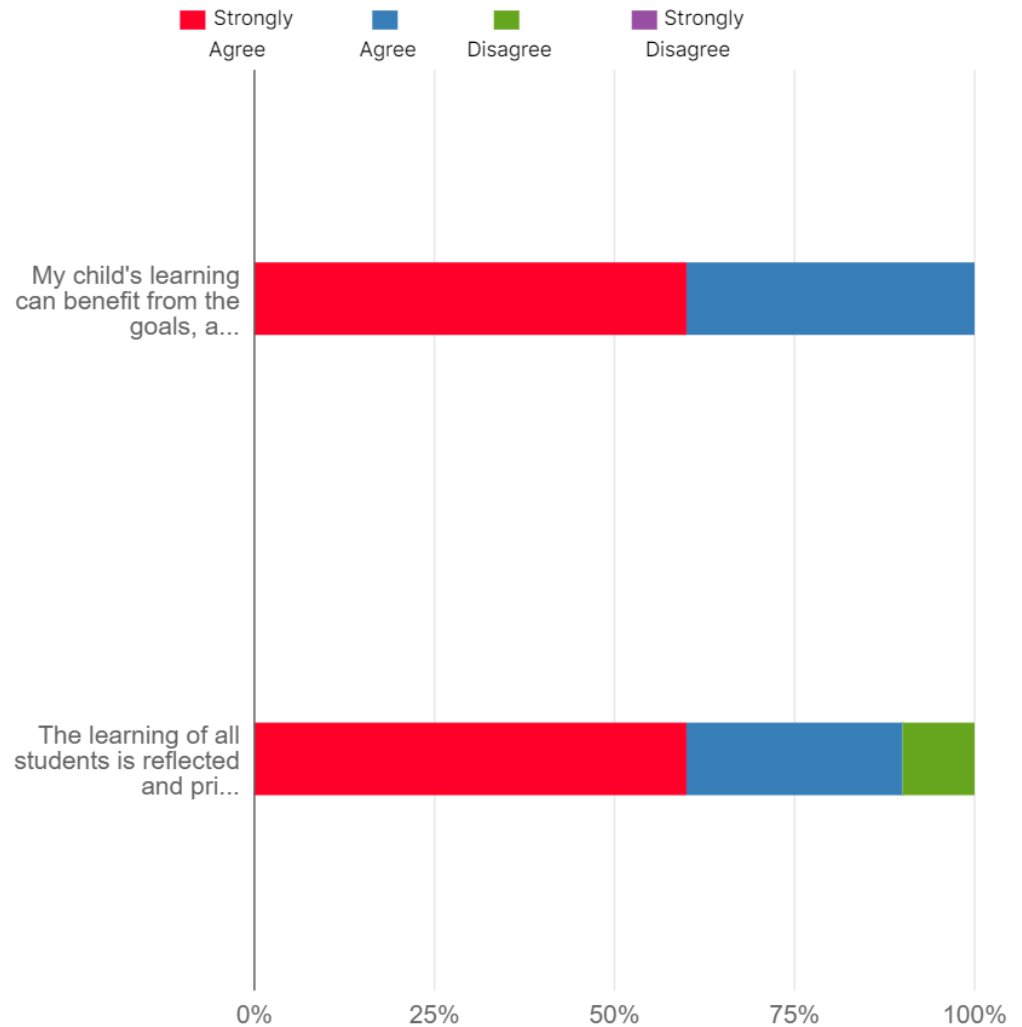

Question #1 - We share SDP information and updates in different ways. Please indicate the ways you have learned about our SDP. Check all that apply.



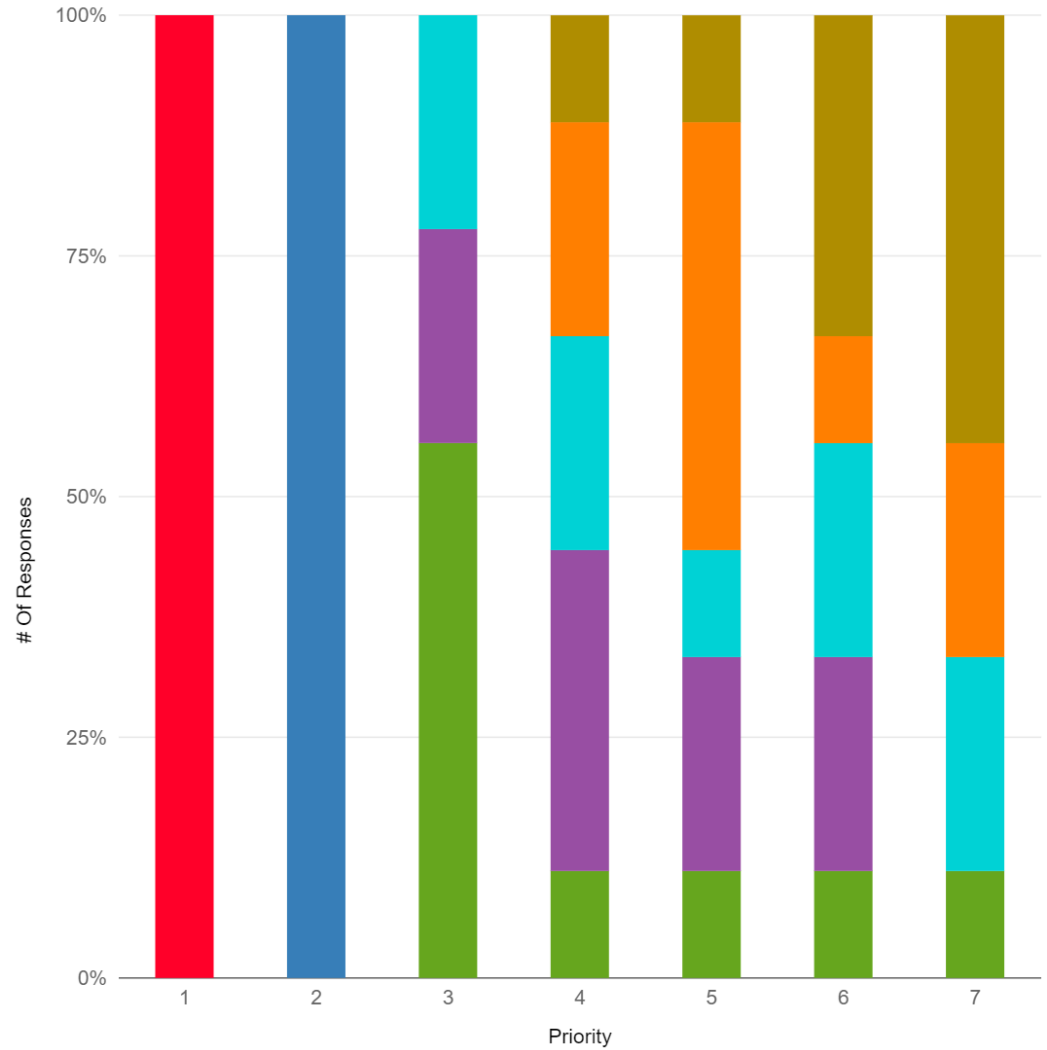
Question #2 - The SDP is developed with all students in mind. Please select your level of agreement with the following statements:

- The new UCP curriculum hinders our learning by the way it was developed and implemented

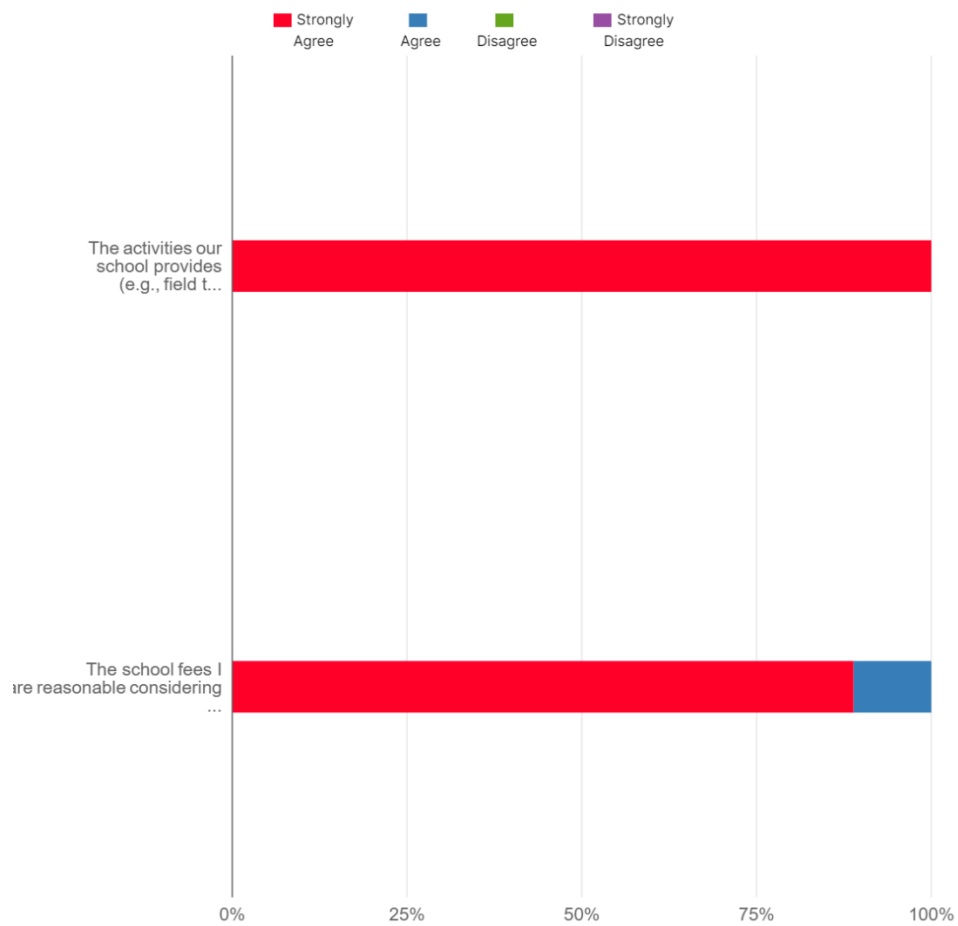
Question #3 - Schools must operate within their budget and too many fees can be unmanageable for families. Knowing that, please rank the following activities and services in order of importance to you.
