WHEN USING ELECTRONIC DEVICES AT SCHOOL...

- ▶ ethical and respectful behaviour when conversing or posting material
- ▶ keep everyone's personal and sensitive information confidential
- ▶ respect copyright and fair use
- ▶ keep digital access information safe
- ▶ ensure personal use does not interfere with your responsibilities
- ▶ access resources for which you have been authorized



INAPPROPRIATE USE

- ▶ hacking or illegal activities
- ▶ accessing, storing or distributing inappropriate electronic material
 - capturing and distributing anyone's image without consent
 - lewd or graphic depictions of violence, sexual acts or body modifications
 - images that promote the use of illegal drugs, tobacco or alcohol
 - material that promotes violence, hatred or misinformation of another person or group
 - unlicensed or illegally obtained digital media and software
 - crude, obscene or vulgar language, gestures or images

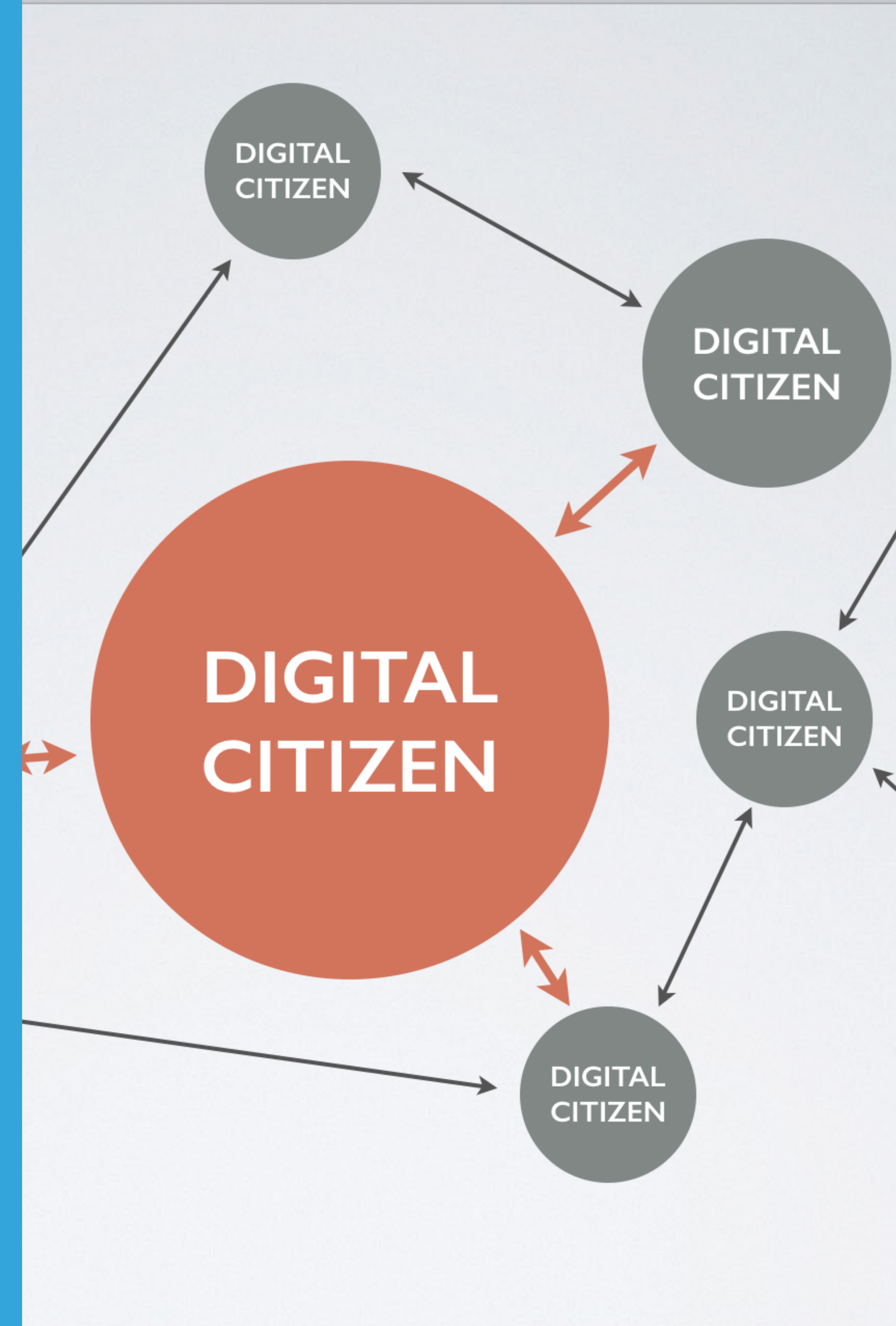
