Conduct and Behaviour Expectations

The following are conduct and behaviour expectations for participants while on the Off-Site Activity – Sunship Earth at YMCA Camp Chief Hector.

The behaviour of each individual affects fellow students, teachers, parents, as well as other travelers and people where we are guests. The consequences of your behaviour are not restricted to you alone. Think before you choose to do something that is questionable. Your personal conduct should be based on mutual respect for the individuals in your group and should be reasonable at all times.

You are an ambassador of our school and community, and foster goodwill and understanding among other students and people of the places that you will visit. This experience will provide you with a better knowledge, understanding, and acceptance of the different cultures of the world and its people.

1 | Participants are required at all times to maintain the highest standards of conduct. In case of serious infractions of the rules, the participant will be sent home at his/her parents/guardians expense. The parent/guardian will be required to come and pick up the student at the soonest possible time at his/her cost.

2 | The Student Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the Off-Site Activity. A copy of this has been reviewed with students and is available to parents at <http://www.cbe.ab.ca/GovernancePolicies/AR6005-Student-Code-of-Conduct.pdf>.

3 | The Teacher-in-Charge in consultation with the supervisors will determine the disciplinary action to be taken in the event that the conduct of any member is unacceptable.

4 | Participants are required to attend all functions as designated in the schedule or as specified by the Teacher-in-Charge and Teacher Supervisors.

5 | No one will be allowed to leave the off-site activity at any point.

6 | Necessary direction and instructions will be issued daily or at each location during the day. These instructions must be adhered to, to assure success, safety and prevent complications.

7 | Curfews will be set daily as required by our obligations for the following day. Any infractions will be dealt with as outlined in items #1 and #3 above.

8 | Everyone is responsible for having his/her luggage ready and in the proper place for loading, as designated by the supervisor.

9 | Students will be respectful, at all times, of themselves, others and Camp Chief Hector YMCA.

Make this Off-Site Activity not only an enjoyable experience, but a memorable experience. Avoid problem situations; take care of yourself and your belongings. Be positive, be pleasant, be co-operative, be humorous, be sociable and above all be understanding. Always conduct yourself in a manner that will be a credit to yourself, to your parents, and to your school.
